

## ROUTE 1

### **Departure : Pte Maillot.**

Take the way in the tunnel under the road and go along the square. Turn right and pass above the Boulevard Périphérique. In front of the street , *Pavillon de l'Orée du Bois*. Go along the Ruisseau d'Armenonville. On the opposite side of the avenue , *Pavillon d'Armenonville*. Cross the Route des Sablons à la Pte Dauphine.

Turn left in the horse way and cross a second road. Continue towards the *shelter*. Turn right in the way which goes to the *Lac Inférieur*. Go along the Lake (*small boats rent*) on the east side until about the half of the lake. Turn left and go along the *pelouse de la Muette*. Continue in the Avenue de St Cloud until the *Place de Colombie*.

Go along the Boulevard Suchet (*looket on the left who shows the altitude of the place*). Turn left and take the *Allée Pilâtre de Rozier* (*Jardin du Ranelagh* , *Musée Marmottan* and ruins of the *Château de la Muette* et departure place of the of Pilâtre de Rozier).

On the place , *Old Station of la Muette* (restaurant now), make a roundtrip along the Boulevard Beauséjour until the *Villa Beauséjour* (Russian Isbas). Turn right in the Rue Largillière, then in the Rue des Vignes. On the left , *Boulaivilliers Station* (House in the station during 50 years , until the station reopens).

Turn right in the Rue de Boulaivilliers then on left in the Rue des Marronniers (*Residences with guard tower*). Turn right in the Rue Raynouard which is along the Maison Radio France , then continue in the Rue La Fontaine. On the right , *Hameau La Fontaine* , then *Castel Béranger* (Door and Building), then *Hameau Béranger*. At the corner of the street , *Café Guimard*. Enter on the left in the *Square du Pré aux Chevaux*.

Turn left in the Rue Gros. Cross the Seine on the Pont de Grenelle and take on the left , the *Allée des cygnes* (dyke dating from the beginning of the 19th century). On right , *small statue of liberty* (a gift from US thanks to the Bartholdi's statue of Liberty at New York).

Cross the Seine on right on the *Pont Bir-Hakeim*. go under the *Tour Eiffel* (build in 1889 for the universal exposition). Near the north pillar , *bust of Gustave Eiffel* and *old brick chimney* for the previous lifts). Cross the *Champ de Mars* (fédération feast the 14th of Juillet 1790). *Small sundial* on a statue. In front of it , *École Militaire* (Created in 1751 by Gabriel for the young people of the nobility). Turn left to the the Place de l'Ecole Militaire then on right in the Avenue de Tourville. *Cariatides* at number 4.

On the left , make a roundtrip in the *jardin de l'intendant* (created in 1980) which is next to the *dôme des Invalides church* (build under Louis the 14th to welcome the amputated injured people). Go out of the park to the south to go on the *Place Vauban* (*statue of Lyautey*) and take the Avenue de Breteuil. Turn left in the Rue d'Estrées. On the right , *St François Xavier Church* (Oriented in the direction of a future avenue which will be never build). Continue in the same way , in the Rue Babylone.

At the angle of the Rue Monsieur , **Pagode** (build in 1896 , old lieu de réception for the China). Turn on right in Rue Monsieur (**Hotel** at number 12) then Rue Oudinot on left. Au 23, is hiding a dead end (**Allée de l'industrie**) behind a door. In front of Rue Oudinot , Dead end Oudinot.

At the corner of the street , **Beautiful display of bakery**. Turn left in Rue Vaneau. At number 50, **Impasse des Artisans**. Turn right in Rue de Babylone. On right , **Jardin Catherine Labouré**. Walk right to the **Hôtel Matignon** (House of Prime minister since 1958).

On right, at 140 Rue du Bac , "**Au Bon Marché**" (Shop dating of 1852) and **chapelle Notre Dame Miraculeuse**. Enter in the **Square Boucicaut** (Statue in it) on right. Take Rue de Sèvres. Arrive at Place de la Croix Rouge (**Statue of César**) and **display** above Société Générale bank.

Make a roundtrip on left to see the **Square Chaise Récamier** (previous place of the Abbaye aux Bois destroyed in 1906). **Display** for Victor Hugo. Continue in the Rue de Sèvres. Turn left in the Rue du Dragon (**Displays for Jean Giono and Victor Hugo**), on right in the Rue B. Palissy then on right in the Rue du Sabot.

Turn left in the Rue du Four (**Display "Au mouton"**). Turn right in the Rue des Canettes. At number 18, **Bas-relief with ducks** (it gave its name to the street).

Turn left in the the Rue Guisarde. Make a roundtrip in the Rue Mabillon. At numbers 6 , 8 ,10 , **Footbridges** because of the exhausted ground. Turn right and go to the **St Sulpice church** (obelisc build in 1727 at the inside of the Church to show the meridian of Paris). **Fountain** on the place.

Turn around the Church and continue in the Rue Garanciere (**fountain** on right). Turn right in the Rue Vaugirard , on the wall, one of the 2 last **mètre-étalon** (the other one is at Place Vendôme). Turn left in the Rue Guynemer which is along the **Jardin du Luxembourg**. Enter in it in the **english type garden (Small statue of the Liberty)**. Turn right and walk along the **Palais du Luxembourg (sénat)** , Statue on left. A Droite, **Médailon** showing the passage of the Méridien de Paris. walk on left side of the **Fontaine Médicis** (build in 1620).

Go out of the park and cross the Place Edmond Rostand. Continue in the same way in the Rue Soufflot (In front of it , the **Panthéon** who has replaced the **Ste Geneviève church** in 1758). Turn right in the Rue le Goff then on right in the Rue Malebranche (**Beautiful display** , with a large key). Continuer in the same way in the Rue des Fossés St Jacques (**engraved name** and **restaurant display**).

Take the Rue de l'Estrapade on the left side then the Rue Blainville. **Engraved name** at the corner of the Rue Tournefort. At the number 9, **Display of 1914** and back yard below (**Ironwork well**). See **a display for the old enclosure of Philippe Auguste** on left in the Rue Descartes. Go to the **Place de l'Estrapade**. Turn right in the Rue Blainville

Display for **Denis Diderot**. Turn right in the **Rue Mouffetard (Au negre Joyeux and Bulls)** (**Fountain** at the angle of the Rue du Pot de Fer). Turn left in the Rue Ortolan then on left in the **Passage Jaillot** which is along a square. Turn right in the Rue St Médard then on left in the Rue Gracieuse then Rue Monge).

Turn right in the Rue Lacepède then on left in Rue Monge. At number 49, *passage* to go to the *Arènes de Lutèce* (Dating from the 2nd century and discovered in 1869 during the creation of Rue Monge). Go out of it on the right and turn left in Rue des Arènes (*Square Capitan* on the left). *Fontaine Wallace* dedicated to Georges Cuvier (Botanist) at the crossroad.

Turn left and enter in the *Jardin des Plantes* (Build under Louis the 13th in 1626). Walk to the top of the hill and see the *Gloriette de Buffon* (1787). Go down and see the *Cèdre de Jussieu* (Planted in 1734). Go along the *Jardin Alpin* (a well is hidden). Turn right 2 times and go to the *Muséum d'Histoire Naturelle*. Go out of the *Jardin des Plantes*. On the right *Paris mosque*. Turn left in the Rue Geoffroy St Hilaire.

On the place , make a round trip to the old *Marché aux Chevaux* (At the 11-13, *Text written and horse head*). Turn left in the Rue de Poliveau (*famous for "Four bags full / La traversée de Paris" movie*). Cross the Boulevard St Marcel. Enter in the hospital *Pitié Salpêtrière* (Build in 1660 by Le Vau to replace an old powder factory).

Enter in the *Chapelle St Louis* (Octogonal) then on right in the *Cour Lassay*. Turn left and cross the *promenade du haut*. *Meridian sundial* on the Chapelle. Go out of the hospital by the Rue Bruant. Turn left in the Boulevard Vincent Auriol and walk on the Pont de Bercy.

Go on the right along the *Palais Omnisports de Bercy* and enter in the *Parc de Bercy* (Old wine warehouses). Walk towards the *Chais de Bercy* and the *vines of Bercy*, the *Maison du Jardinage* and the *Orangerie*. Take the footbridge above the street and go towards the *Maison du Lac*. On right , *Village de Bercy*. Come back the J. Kessel street. Walk along the *Notre Dame de la Nativité church* and turn right in the Rue des Fonds Verts.

Continue on the same way to the Rue Taine and turn on the left in the *Rue de la Durance* (The street is separated in 2 parts because of the old wall of Fermiers Généraux). Reach the Boulevard de Reuilly and take it on the right. On the Felix Eboué place (*station style Guimard*).

Turn on the left in the Avenue Daumesnil and in the Rue Brahms on the right. Take the *Promenade Plantée* (Old railroad track) and take it on the right until the *square Charles Péguy* and go downstairs.

Turn right in the Rue Rottembourg then on left in the Rue de la Véga then on left in Avenue Daumesnil. Walk below the *Petite Ceinture*. Continue that way until the *Lac Daumesnil*.
