

ROUTE 2

Departure : Porte de la villette

Take the alley on right , and walk along the *Cité des Sciences et de l'Industrie*. Take the *galerie de la Villette* et take the *footbridge* above the *Canal de l'Ourcq*. Continue on the galerie de la Villette. On right , *Cinaxe* and behind , *the locks of the canal St Denis*. Walk along the *Pavillon du Charolais* then along the *Grande Halle de la Villette* (slaughterhouse from 1860 to 1976) (Halle Baltard). Continue in the Sente des Dorées.

Continue in the same way in the *Allée D. Milhaud* (Old Railroad which joined the *Petite Ceinture* and *slaughterhouses of la Villette* , *Station 'Paris Bestiaux'*). Turn left in the 2nd upstairs then on the opposite side of the crossroad.

Take the *Rue des Carrières d'Amérique* then on right the *Villa Manin* (Villas of the 19th century). Turn right in the Rue de la Solidarité then on left in the Rue d'Alsace Lorraine then on right in the Rue Gaston Pinot (*Residences*). Continue in the same way and take the Rue F. Pinton.

Go upstairs and arrive at the *Villa Claude Monet* (Mouzaïa district build in 1901) (Old place of quarries). Continue in the same way to arrive in the *Villa Cronstadt*. Turn left in the Rue du Général Brunet then on right in the *Villa de Fontenay* (beautiful displays). Turn left in the Rue de la Liberté (*Beautiful houses* at numbers 6 and 8). Turn right in the *Villa du Progrès* (Small courtyard with vine) then in the *Villa de Bellevue*.

Turn left in the Rue Arthur Rozier then go downstairs to arrive in the Rue de Crimée then enter in the *Parc des Buttes Chaumont* (Old place of quarries , build in 1867). On left , *Botzaris station style Guimard*. On right , railroads of the *Petite Ceinture*. On left , *Salon Weber*. Turn right to go on the *Pont des Suicidés* then in the *Temple de Vesta* (like the Tivoli at Roma). Go downstairs and turn right to walk on the *bridge*.

Continue in the same way and go downstairs to walk along the *lake* on the left. Turn left and walk in the *cave* (Old enter of the quarries). Turn left and walk under the *Pont des suicidés*. Turn left and walk along the small waterfalls , then exit of the park by the *Porte Secrétan*.

In front of the exit , *Fondation Ophtalmologique* (Build in 1905). Turn left in the Rue Manin et go upstairs on right (*78 steps*) to arrive at the *Butte Bergeyre* (Build in 1927 on the place of an old stadium). Turn left in the Rue Barrelet de Ricou then in the Rue Edgar Poe. *Beautiful houses* in the Rue Rémy de Gourmont. Walk towards the *Vines* (sightseeing on Montmartre). On left , Rue Lardennois (*small sundial* at number 83). Go downstairs on right by the Rue Tagrine on left to arrive on the Avenue Mathurin Moreau.

Turn left to take the Avenue Simon Bolivar. Turn right in the Rue Henri Turot then slightly on right in the Rue du Vicq d'Azir. Turn left in the Rue de la Grange aux Belles. Turn right in the Rue de *l'Hôpital St Louis* (Build in 1607 for Henri the 4th). Turn left and walk along the *Canal St Martin* (Build to supply Drinking water to Paris in 1822). At number 102, *Hôtel du Nord* (Famous movie with Arletty). Towards the footbridge , *double lock* and *rotating bridge*.

Continue in the same way until the *Square Lemaitre* (around a lock). Turn right in the Rue du Faubourg du Temple. *Courtyard* at number 18. Walk around the Place de la République. At number 41 of the Bd du Temple , *Théâtre Paris Dejazet*.

Take on right , the *Passage Vendôme* (Build at the place of the couvent des filles du sauveur , to join the Place de la République and the Carreau du Temple , dating of 1827). Turn left in the Rue Béranger and right in the Rue Dupuis (On right , *Picturesque place*).

Make a roundtrip on right to the *Cité Dupetit Thouars* (House of artisans who supplied the Carreau du Temple). Take the Rue des Archives. On right , Rue Perrée , See a *sundial*. On right , *Square du Temple* (Dating of 1853 , old place of the monastère des templiers). Take lightly on left , the Rue de Beauce (*engraved name*). Turn left in the Rue Pastourelle.

On right , *Ruelle Sourdis* (medieval style). Turn left in the Rue Charlot (*engraved name*). On left , *Cathédrale Ste Croix*. Turn left in the Rue du Perche. Turn right in the Rue Vieille du Temple. *Hotel Salé* on left. At the corner of the street , *Hôtel de Rohan* (Build in 1705, 'Chevaux du Soleil' above the door). Turn right in the Rue des 4 fils. On right , at number 16 , *sundial*.

Walk along the *Archives Nationales* and the *Musée de l'Histoire de France* (Hôtel de Soubise) and the *Musée de la Chasse et de la Nature* (Hôtel Guénégaud build by Mansart in 1655). At the corner , *Fontaine des Haudriettes* (build in 1624). Turn left in the Rue des Archives. At the corner of the Rue Braque, *Porte de Clisson* (2 turrets in encorbelment).

At the following corner , *Hôtel de Soubise* (Build in 1375 under Du Guesclin). On right , at number 45 , *sundial*. Turn left in the Rue des Francs Bourgeois. At number 57bis, *Tower of the old enclosure of Philippe Auguste* (about 800 years old). On left , *Musée des archives* then *Hôtel d'Assy* , then *Hôtel de Fontenay* then *Hôtel Jaucourt*.

Walk behind the *Eglise N. D. des Blancs Manteaux*. At the corner of the street , *J. Hérouet house* (Turret dating from Louis the 12th). Turn left in the Rue Vieille du Temple. On right , *Square CH. V. Langlois*. Turn left in the Rue du Marché des Blancs Manteaux then on right , the Rue des Hospitalières St Gervais. At number 8 , *Bulls* at the place of an old market.

Turn right , in the Rue des Rosiers. At the corner , *Hôtel Amelot de Bisseul* (Old place in 1655 of the house of the weapon companions of Du Guesclin). Turn left in the Rue Vieille du Temple (*beautiful displays*). On left , *Rue du Trésor* (Name given to the dead end because of the discover of gold under an old hotel in 1882). On left, "*A la ville de Rodez*" and at number 24, *iron door*. On left , *Impasse de l'Hôtel d'Argenson* (Engraved 'Cul de Sac d'Argenson').

A few meters on right, display "*Achat de Chevaux*". Turn left in the Rue du Roi de Sicile then on right in the Rue Cloche Perce. Cross the Rue de Rivoli (At number 23 , *Restaurant with jars*) and continue in the Rue Cloche Perce (*Stairs*). Turn right in the Rue François Miron. At numbers 13 and 11, *Half timbered houses* (Dating from Louis the 11th , elm leaves in ironworks).

Turn left in the Rue des Barres. On right , *Eglise St Gervais St Protais* (2 roman officers tortured by Nero) with the *Orme St Gervais* (Justice was given under it) on the place. Turn left in the Rue des Justes (old Grenier à l'Eau).

Walk along the *Mémorial du Martyr Juif Inconnu*. Turn left in the Rue Geoffroy d'Asnier (*Beautiful wooden house*). Walk along the *Hôtel Chalons Luxembourg*. On left in the Rue François Miron, at number , beautiful display "*au Cheval de Sable*", At number 23, Display "*Orthopédie*" with a tilted P. Walk along the *Hôtel de Beauvais* (City house of the Abbaye de Chaalis).

At number 133 of Rue St Antoine , *Chimeras and Balconies* with ironworks at the 1st floor. Turn right in the small Rue du Prévôt ("*rue Percée* " at the 13th century). At number 5 , *Vaults and handles*. Turn left in the Rue Charlemagne. On left , *Eglise St Paul St Louis* (the only church of Jesuits in Paris).

Turn right in the Rue des Jardins St Paul and walk along the Enclosure of *Philippe Auguste* (Visible, dating from 1190). Turn left and enter in the *village St Paul*. Turn right in the Rue de l'Ave Maria. At the crossroad , *Hôtel de Sens* (Build in 1475 by Sens archbishop). July 1830 the 28th , during a revolution , *a bullet falled in the wall of the hotel*.

Continue in the Rue de l'Hôtel de Ville. On right , *Jardins de l'Hotel de Sens*. Turn left to walk on the Pont Marie and turn left in the Quai d'Anjou. At number 27, *Beautiful hotel* where lived the Marquise de Lambert. Turn right in the Rue Poulletier.

At the corner of the street , *Eglise St Louis en l'Ile* (build between 1664 and 1726, woodworks , marbles and a large clock). Turn right in the Rue St Louis en l'Ile. At number 51, *Hôtel de Chenizot* (Door with a wildcat head). At in the inside of the hotel, in the 2nd courtyard, *sundial*. On right, *old Nicolas Shop*. Walk on the Pont St Louis. Turn right in the Rue du Cloître Notre Dame then on right in the Rue Chanoinesse.

Turn left in the Rue des Chantres , *Hôtel de Chantre* (dating from the 17th century). At the end of the street, display showing the level of the *flood in 1910*. On the quay , on right , at number 9-11 , display showing the old house of *Héloïse and Abélard* (Dating from 1118).

At the corner of the Rue des Ursins (1-3) and Rue des Chantres , *spoof of an medieval house*. At number 6, *big bellied house*. Beautiful house on left. Turn left in the Rue de la Colombe. Display for the *enclosure Gallo Roman* and *Map of France*. Cabaret on left was already here in 1250. At number 26, in the backyard , *letters engraved on the ground*. At number 22 and 24 , *Chanoinesses houses* dating from 16th century. At number 17, *monolithic stone*.

Turn right in the Rue Massillon. Turn left in the Rue du Cloître Notre Dame then enter on right in the *Square Jean XXIII* (Old square de l'Archevêché). Turn right along the Seine (Old place of the *Hôtel Dieu*) et and walk along the *Cathédrale Notre Dame* (Build between 1163 and 1345). Turn left on the Pont au Double.

Turn left in the Rue de la Bûcherie then on right in the Rue de *l'Hôtel Colbert* (Old name : Rue des Rats). Old place of the Hôtel Colbert. At numbers 12 and 14 , *Hotels of the 17th century*. Cross the Rue Lagrange. Continue in the *Rue Galande* (Old roman way to Lyon). At number 31 , *Gable of the 15th century*. At number 42 , *Engraved stone* (Low relief with St Julien in his boat). At numbers 46 to 54 , *ogive and medieval caves*.

Turn right in the Rue St Julien le Pauvre and walk along the *church*. At numbers 4 , 6 and 10 , *Medieval caves* on 3 floors.

At number 11 , **Old house**. Enter on right in the **Square René Viviani**. In the center of the square , **Robinier** planted in 1601 and a **well**. Another well in front of the Church. Turn left in the Rue de la Bûcherie (dating from the 6th century). At number 37 , **Fountain Wallace** , At number 39 , **one of the smallest houses of Paris**.

Continue in the Rue de la Huchette. At number 4 , small display "**A la Hure d'Or**", at number 14 , **Y of a mercier**. On right , **Small Rue du Chat qui pêche**. At number 57 , **Théâtre de la Huchette** with always the same play. On left , **Fountain St Michel** (Dating from 1860). Take the **small passage** in the Rue de l'Hirondelle then on left in the Rue Git le Coeur.

Turn right in the **Rue St André des Arts**. **Beautiful bookshop** on left and **engraved name** of the Rue Séguier. Turn left in the **Cour du Commerce st André**. At number 13, **Café Procope** (where writers met during the french revolution). On left , **Cour Rohan** (Old house of Diane de Poitiers and Enclosure of Philippe Auguste). Turn right in the Rue de l'Ancienne comédie.

Turn left in the **Rue de Buci** (Engraved name "Rue de Bussi") , then on right in the Rue Bourbon le Château (**Typical crossroad**). Turn right in the Rue Cardinale , **old houses** at numbers 3 to 9. Turn left in the Rue de Furstemberg. On the small place , **Musée Delacroix** (Build in 1863 where Delacroix lived and died). At numbers 6 and 8 , old place of the **backyards and stables of the abbey** (1669), It remains common rooms.

Turn left in the Rue de la Petite Boucherie (which is behind the **St Germain des Prés church** and the **Square Laurent Prache**) then continue in the Rue Mabillon. At numbers 6,8 and 10 , **footbridges** because of te exhausted ground. Turn left in the Rue Guisarde then on left in the Rue des Canettes (at number 18 , **Low relief with ducks**).

On the place , **Eglise St Sulpice** (repair in 1646) , **Obelisc** indicating 12 o'clock at the inside (build in 1727 on the Paris meridian) and **fountain** on the place. Walk along the church by the left side.

Turn right in the Rue Pallatine. **Typical place**. Turn right in the Rue de la Garancière (**fountain**). Turn right in the Rue Vaugirard. **Etalon meter** (dating from 1795, one of the two remaining in Paris). Enter in the **Jardin du Luxembourg** (Bought by Marie de Médicis after the death of Henri IV). Walk along the **Palais du sénat**. Turn on the left towards the **Fountain Médicis** (Build in 1620 by Salomon de Brosse).

Turn left in the Rue Corneille. **Beautiful display** on right in the Rue Racine (Chartier). Continue in the Rue Delavigne , then in the Rue A. Dubois. Turn right in the Rue de l'Ecole de Medecine. Continue on left in the Rue du Sommerard (**Abbaye de Cluny**). Turn right in the Rue Chénard. Cross the Rue des Ecoles (**Square Mariette**).

Turn left in the Rue Lanneau then right in the Rue Valette. At number 19-21 , **Hexagonal tower** of 1560. Sightseeing on the **Panthéon** (Build at the place of the Ste Genevieve Abbey in 1758). Turn right in the Rue Laplace. At number 12 , **Beautiful porch** with 2 levels (Old school) and **café**. Turn right in the Rue de la Montagne Ste Geneviève (at number 34 on left , "**séminaire des 33**") , at number 51 , **Door with ironwork**. Turn right in the Rue St Etienne au Mont. **Small door** at number 18.

Walk along the **Eglise St Etienne du Mont** (Dating from 1541). Turn right in the Rue Descartes. On left, **Tour Clovis** (piece of the Enclosure of Philippe Auguste).

On right , *Display for the old place of the Enclosure of Philippe Auguste*. Continue until the *Place de la Contrescarpe (Pomme de Pin* on the place), and then in the Rue Mouffetard (Display *Au negre Joyeux*) and *old Epicerie*. At number 6 , *Old display with 2 bulls* dating from the 18th century. At number 50 , *old attic* , At number 69 , Display "*Au vieux Chêne*".

At number 81 , *Door* dating from the 17th century. At 103 , *display about the Siège de Paris* in 1871. On right , *Passage des Postes*. On left , *Passage des Patriarches* and *Boucherie des Patriarches*. At number 122 , "*A la bonne source*" (well in the restaurant). At number 134 , Beautiful display of *Facchetti house*. Walk along the *Eglise St Médard*.

Turn right in the Rue de la Clef. *Square Scipion* and *Hôtel Scipion* (Old place of central bakery for Paris hospitals , built in the 17th century). Turn right in the Rue Vésale (*Old sub-station*) then in the Rue de la Collégiale on left. Continue in the Rue M. Peter at the opposite side of the avenue. Turn right in the Rue de la Reine Blanche.

Continue in the Rue des Gobelins , au 3bis , *Old Orangery* dating of 1686 , at numbers 17-19, *château de la " Reine Blanche "* (dating of the 15th century) and old gate . Turn left in the Rue Gustave Geffroy then on left in the Rue Barbier de Mets (*Old bed of the Bievre*).

On left , *Manufacture des Gobelins* (dating of 1441 , was along the Bievre). Walk along the "*Mobilier National*" (Mobilier for the ministers). Enter on right in the *Square René le Gall* (Build in 1938 above the Bièvre).

Turn left in the Rue Vulpian then on left in the Rue Le Dantec on the other side of the Bd Auguste Blanqui. Turn right in the Rue Barrault. Make a roundtrip on right in the Rue Daviel. at number 10 , *Petite Russie* and *Petite Alsace* (Houses built in 1912 for social houses). On the other side of the street , *Villa Daviel*. Turn right in the Rue Barrault then on left in the Rue Michal. We arrive at the *Butte aux Cailles* (Typical place).

Turn right in the Rue de l'Esperance and continue in the Rue Auguste Lancon. on the crossroad , beautiful house. Enter on right in the Cité Florale (old place of a lake in the 19th century) : Turn right in the Rue des *Orchidées* , then in the *Rue des Glycines*, then on right in the Rue Brillât savarin , then *Rue des Iris* then *Rue des Volubilis*. Get out by the Rue Auguste Lancon and take it on left. Turn right in the Rue Liard which is along the *Petite Ceinture*.

Enter in the *Parc Montsouris* (Built by Napoléon III in 1867) by the stairs. Continue in the way which arrives the alley with the *Mire du sud*, then turn right before the station of the RER B. See the *Petite Ceinture*. Turn left to rejoin the RER.
