

## ROUTE 3

### Departure : Porte Maillot

Take the Rue du Débarcadère on right and arrive on a *small place*. Turn left in the Rue St Ferdinand. On right , *Cité St Ferdinand* and *Eglise St Ferdinand Ste Thérèse de l'enfant Jésus*. Cross the Place Tristan Bernard and turn left in the Rue Guersant. Turn right in the Rue Torricelli. On left , *Marché des Ternes*.

Turn right in the Rue Bayen. Walk under the building (Old *château des Ternes* dating from 1634). Cross the Avenue Niel. On right , *FNAC building*. Turn left in the Rue Fourcroy then on right in the Rue Laugier. Take the *Passage Poncelet* and turn left in Rue Poncelet. Turn right in the Rue des Renaudes. Cross the Avenue de Wagram then the Bd de Courcelles.

Continue in the Rue Pierre le Grand. At the end of the street , *Cathédrale Orthodoxe Alexandre Newsky* (néo-byzantin dating from 1861). Turn left in the Rue Daru then on right in the Rue de Courcelles. Turn left in the Avenue Van Dyck. Make a roundtrip , at *8 Rue Vigny* , beautiful typical house in a courtyard.

At number 5 , *Hôtel* which was owned by Menier. Enter in the *Parc Monceau* (Build in 1769 by the Duc de Chartres, English style). Get out of the park by the left side to the Place de la République Dominicaine (*station style guimard*). Turn on right in the Rue Thann which arrives on the Place du Général Catroux. On right , *Building of the Banque de France* (Hotel Gaillard dating from 1884).

Take the Rue J. Bingen. *Beautiful church* at the crossroad. Turn right in the Rue de Tocqueville. Turn left in the Rue de la Terrasse (*Villa de la Terrasse* on left). Turn left in the *Rue de Lévis* (Street with a lot of shops). Turn right in the Rue Legendre (then on left in the *Square Claude Debussy*. Turn right in the Square F. de la Tombelle then on right in the Square G. Fauvé. Turn left in the Rue Legendre (*Beautiful house at the crossroad*) then on left in the Rue Salneuve. Walk on the bridge which is above the railroads of St Lazare.

Enter on right in the *Square des Batignolles*. Get out of the park at the opposite site and walk along the *Eglise Ste Marie des Batignolles*. Turn left in the Rue Legendre then on right in the Rue Lamandé. Turn left in the Rue Bridaine then on right in the Rue Truffaut.

Turn left in the Rue de la Condamine then on right in the Rue Lemercier. At number 28 , *Cité Lemercier* (Jacques Brel lived here during his youth). Turn left in the Rue Hélène. Cross the Avenue de Clichy then continue in the Rue Ginier. On the small place , on left , *Villa P. Ginier* and *Villa des Arts* (Old houses of artists). Turn right in the Rue Henri moreau then in the Rue Cavalotti , then in the Rue Forest. Turn left in the Rue Caulaincourt.

On both sides , *Cimetière de Montmartre* (graves of Sacha Guitry and Dalida). Turn left in the Rue Damrémont. On left , at 22 Rue Tourlaque, "*Les Fusains*" (Artists workshop). Turn right in it and on left in the Rue Lepic. On left , *Passage Depaquit* , then *Moulin de la Galette*. On right , Rue Tholoze , *sightseeing* on Paris. *Moulin Radet* at the crossroad.

Turn left in the Rue Girardon. On right , in the Rue Norvins , "**Passe Muraille**". On left , **Château des Brouillards** (Build in 1764 at the place of a ruined old house). Arrive Place Dalida (**Bust**). Turn right in the Rue de l'Abreuvoir (**Sundial**) , on right **Jardin St Vincent**. At the crossroad , **Pinkish house** painted by Utrillo and on left , **Lapin Agile** (Old cabaret of killers) and the **Vines of Montmartre** (Butte Montmartre was called at middle age the " Mont des martyrs ").

On left , in the Rue Cortot **Musée de Montmartre** (Build in the oldest house of Montmartre). slightly on left , **display** for J.B. Clément and for Montmartre. Restaurant "A la bonne franquette" at the corner. Turn left in the Rue Norvins and arrive at the **Place du Tertre** (at 3 , **old town hall of Montmartre**). Turn right in the Rue St Eleuthère. On right , small **amphitheatre**.

Go downstairs in the Rue Foyatier which is along the **funicular** and the **Square Willette** (dating from 1929). Sightseeing on the **Sacré Coeur**. On left , **Halle St Pierre** (Bronze display dating from the 18th century , **Musée de l'Art Naïf**). Continue in the Rue Steinkerque. On right , **Display Belle Epoque of Elysée Montmartre**. station Anvers (**Edicule Guimard**).

Cross the avenue and enter in the **Square d'Anvers**. Turn left in the Avenue Trudaine then on right in the Rue Rochechouart. At number 58 , **Cité Napoléon** (Houses of factory workers in 1849). Arrive on a small place and turn left in the Rue Condorcet. Turn left in the Rue de Maubeuge , and in the Rue d'Abbeville on right. Beautiful display at the corner. At number 14 , "**Vegetal display**". On left , **Eglise St Vincent de Paul**.

Turn right in the Rue d'Hauteville then on left in th Rue de Chabrol on left. Enter in the **Cité d'Hauteville** then take again the Rue d'Hauteville on left. Turn left in the Rue du Paradis and walk in front of the **Musée des cristalleries Baccarat** (Worshops dating of Louis the 15th).

Above the **Galerie Paradis** , **stained glasses display** (Old Faience manufacture). Continue in the Rue de la Fidélité and cross the Bd Magenta. Enter in the **Square St Laurent**. **St Laurent Church** on left. Take the **Passage des récollets** which turns left. At the opposite side of the street , **Square Villemin** (Old brood of the Récollets) .

Take the footbridge above the **Canal St Martin**. In front of the footbridge , at 102 quai de Jemmapes , **Hôtel du Nord** (from the movie). Walk along the Canal St Martin on left and turn right in the Rue de **Hopital St Louis** (Build in 1607 for Henri 4th). Turn left in the Rue des Granges aux Belles then in the Rue du Vicq d'Azir on right. Turn left in the Rue Henri Turot. Continue on left in the Avenue Simon Bolivar.

Turn right in the Avenue Mathurin Moreau then on right in the Rue Georges Lardennois. Take the stairs on right of the Rue Michel Tagrine to arrive to the top of the **Butte Bergeyre** (Build in 1927 at the place of an old stadium). On right , **sightseeing on Paris** , **Sacré coeur** and **vines** of the Butte Bergeyre. On right , Rue Lardennois (**small sundial** at number 83).Turn right in the **Rue Edgar Poe**.

Beautiful houses in the **Rue Rémy de Gourmont** on right. At the end of the street , turn left in the **Rue Barrelet de Ricou** and **go downstairs** (78 steps) on right. Turn left in the Rue Manin. On left , **Fondation Ophthalmologique** (Build in 1905) and enter on right in the **Parc des Buttes Chaumont** (Build in 1867 at the place of old carreys). Go out of the park by the Rue Botzaris on right. On left , **Villa du Parc** and **Square Bolivar**.

Turn right and go downstairs in the Rue de l'Equerre. Turn left in the Rue Rébéval (**Old Meccano factory** on right). Cross the Rue de Belleville (sightseeing on Paris on right) and turn left in the Rue Jouve Rouye. At 21 Rue Ramponeau , "**La Forge**". Enter on left in the **Parc de Belleville**. Go upstairs on left to have a sightseeing on Paris.

Make a roundtrip at 25 , Rue des envierges , a **small wood** behind the doors. Turn right in the Rue du Transvaal. On right , at number 16 , **Villa Castel**. Turn right in the **passage Plantin**. In front of the stairs , **Cité Antoine Loubeyre**. Turn right in the Rue des Couronnes , then on left , in the Rue Henri Chevreau (**Petite Ceinture** and **Footbridge of the Rue de la Mare**).

Turn left in the Rue de la Mare. On left , other side of the **Cité Antoine Loubeyre**. Turn right in the Rue des Savies. At the end of the street , **Regard St Martin** ("Fontaine Henri IV" dating from 1583). **Old Restaurant** on left. Turn right in the Rue des Cascades. Make a roundtrip at number 42 , **Regard des Messiers**. Turn left in the **Rue Fernand Raynaud** (small passage) then in the Rue de l'Ermitage on right , then in the **Villa de l'Ermitage** on right.

On left , at the end of the villa , **Cité Leroy**. Turn left to go to the Place du Guignier (On the place , **Maison des Services des Egouts de Paris**). Turn right in the Rue du Guignier , then on right in the Rue des Rigoles. turn slightly on left to take the **Passage de la Duée** (Thinnest passage in Paris , 2 feets large). Turn on right and enter in the **Square Ménilmontant** until the Rue de Ménilmontant to take on right (Sightseeing on Paris). On left , Square Briceux , on right , old brood.

Turn left in the Rue du Retrait. At number 17 , dead end with **beautiful houses** with old bricks. On right , **église Notre Dame Auxiliatrice** at the inside of the Théâtre de Ménilmontant. On the other side of the Rue des Pyrénées, see **Passage des soupirs** (Beautiful wood house). Turn right in the Rue d'Annam. At number 17 , Arcade with "**Groupe des maisons ouvrières**" engraved. Turn right in the Rue Villiers d'Adam. Turn left in the Rue Sorbier. Arrive at Place Martin Nadaud (**Old subway station**).

Turn slightly on left to take the Rue des Rondeaux , which is along the **Cimetière du Père Lachaise**. Turn left in the Rue Charles Renouvier and take the Passage Stendhal on right. Turn right in the Rue Stendhal and go downstairs. Arrive on the **Place St Blaise** (Charonne Village). On left , **Cimetière de Charonne** and **Eglise St Germain de Charonne** (dating from the 11th Century, sundial on the Church). On right , **Eglise Ste Cyrille Ste Méthode**.

Cross the street and take the Rue St Blaise (**Beautiful street**). On right , **Passage des 2 portes**. Turn right in the Rue Vitruve. Turn left in the Rue A. Marquet which is along the **Petite Ceinture** , then in the Rue Courat. Turn right under the bridge. Turn left in the Rue des Maraîchers. Cross the Rue d'Avron. **Avron station** on left. Turn left in the Rue du Volga.

Turn right in the Rue des Grands Champs then on right to rejoin the Rue des Maraichers and turn left. Turn left in the Rue Philidor (**Display with a cow** above a restaurant). At the end of the street , **Dépôt RATP de Charonne**. Turn right in the Passage de Lagny. On left, **lone level crossing** existing in Paris. Continue in the Rue du Général Niessel until Porte de Vincennes.
