

ROUTE 4

Departure : Les Moulineaux (T2)

Cross the Pont de Billancourt and turn right in the Avenue Jean Monnet which leads to the *Parc départemental de l'Île St Germain* (Tower with Figures). Turn left and pass on the Pont d'Issy. Turn right in the Rue des Peupliers. Turn right in the Rue des Enfants du Paradis and the Rue de l'Arroseur arrosé. Turn left in the Avenue du Jour se lève which is along the Bd Périphérique. Turn right in the Avenue George Lafont.

Arrive at the Place de la Porte de St Cloud. Turn right in the Rue Godin (*Beautiful display* of Restaurant) and on left in the Rue Le Marois. Cross the Avenue de Versailles (Place Paul Reynaud). Continue in the Rue Boileau. Turn left in the Rue Parent de Rosan.

On right , *Villa Emile Meyer*. Turn right in the *Villa Dietz Monin* (Villa Mulhouse, House build in 1890 by factory workers). At the end of the Villa , *Villa Cheysson*. Turn right and walk along the *Eglise Tous les Saints de la terre Russe*. Turn left in the Rue Boileau and walk along the Bd Exelmans (*Guimard Building*) and continue in the Rue Chardon Lagache (*Station style Guimard*).

At the crossroad , on right , *Villa de la Reunion* and on left *Villa Molitor*. Turn left in the Rue Jouvenet then on right in the Rue Boileau. On left , *Hameau Boileau* (Neo classical houses , build in 1838 to replace the old house of Nicolas Boileau). Make a roundtrip on left in the Rue Molitor to see the *Villa Boileau*. Continue in the Rue Boileau and turn right in the Rue d'Auteuil. *Beautiful bakery* at the crossroad.

Cross the Rue Chardon Lagache (on right , *Station Eglise d'auteuil* style Guimard) and walk along the *Eglise Notre Dame d'Auteuil*. Turn left in the Rue A. Houcher and walk along the Rue Mirabeau on left to arrive on the Place de Barcelone (*Station Mirabeau* style Guimard). Walk on the Pont Mirabeau.

Station of *Javel* on left. Turn right along the Seine to enter in the *Parc André Citroën* (Build in 1992 at the place of old Citroen cars factory. Cross the park by the middle and arrive at the *Jardin noir* (On right , *Petite Ceinture railroads*). Go out of the park by the Rue St Charles and cross it. Take the Rue Modigliani to arrive in the *Square Jean Cocteau* (Stone Fountain). Turn right to arrive on the Avenue Félix Faure and take it on left.

Go slightly on left in the Rue de Lourmel. Turn right in the Rue Duranton and enter on left in the *Jardin Duranton*. Cross the Rue de la Convention and continue in the Rue Sarasate. Turn left in the Rue Oscar Roty then on right in the Rue de Lourmel. Turn right in the Rue de l'Eglise. Enter on left in the *Square Violet* (Castle built in 1824 with the name of "Château de Grenelle"). Continue in the Rue Violet then turn right in the Rue Lakanal which is along the *Jardin de la Place du Commerce*. Turn right in the *Passage des Entrepreneurs*.

Turn left in the Rue des Entrepreneurs. On right , *Eglise St Jean Baptiste de Grenelle*. Turn left in the Rue de la Croix Nivert , then on right the Rue Mademoiselle then on right the Rue du Dr Jacquemaire and enter in the *Square St Lambert*. Go out of the park on left to take the Rue L. Séché and walk towards the *Mairie du 15e Arrondissement*.

Enter in the *Square Adolphe Chérier*. Make a roundtrip on left in the *Square Vergennes* (Workshop dating of 1932). Turn right in the Rue Bausset then on right in the Rue R. Gerbert which is along the *Eglise St Lambert de Vaugirard* and the Square Gerbert. Turn left in the Rue Fenoux then on right in the Rue de l'Abbé Groult , then on left in the Rue Blomet. Turn left in the Rue Alain Charrier.

Turn right in the Rue de Vaugirard. Turn left in *square* next to the Hospital Vaugirard. Continue in the Rue Malassis then slightly on right in the Rue de la Saïda. Turn left in the Passage de Dantzig. On left , *La Ruche* (Workshop of painters , wine house during the universal exposition in 1900). Continue in the Rue de Dantzig , on right , "*fourrière municipale*". Turn right in the Rue des Morillons (*Found objects*).

Turn right and enter in the *Parc Georges Brassens* (dating of 1978 , Old slaughterhouses of Vaugirard and halles). On right *Théâtre Sylvia Monfort* and *Petite ceinture* railroads with an *old station*. Get out of the park by the Rue des Morillons. Turn left in the Rue Santos Dumont. On left , *Villa Santos Dumont* (Houses where lived a lot of famous people including Georges Brassens).

Turn right in the Rue Franquet then on right in the Rue Labrouste. Turn left in the Rue de l'Harmonie then on left in the Rue Castagnary (On right , *Fish shop with a lighthouse* on it). At the crossroads , *Old building of Bains-Douches*. Turn right in the Rue Vouillé which is below the railroad tracks. Turn right in the *Square Alésia Ridder* Then turn right in the Rue des Suisses. Continue in the Rue Jonquoy and turn right in the *Rue Didot*.

On right , *Villa Collet* , *Villa Mallebay* , on left , *Villa Duthy* , *Villa Jamot* and *Villa Deshayes*. On right , *Allée des Hortensias*. Turn left in the Rue Ledion then in the Rue Giordano Bruno which is along the *Petite Ceinture*. Turn left in the Rue des Plantes. Make a roundtrip on right in the *Villa d'Alésia* (dating from 1897). On left , *Villa des Plantes* , then on right , *Villa Moderne*.

Cross the Place Gilbert Perroy. On left , *squares de l'Aspirant Dunand and Ferdinand Brunot*. On left , *Villa Louvat*. Turn right in the Rue Ernest Cresson. Walk along the Avenue du Général Leclerc. On left , *Villa Adrienne* (1780 , At the beginning , it was build to welcome military people and church men). *Mouton Duvernet station*.

Turn left in the Rue Sophie Germain then on left in the *Rue Hallé* (On left , *Villa Hallé*). It arrives on a '*half-moon*' place. Turn right in the Rue d'Alembert then , on right in the Rue de la Tombe Issore. On right , *Eglise moderne*. On left , *Cité Hannibal* (Half well). At number 83 , *Flower dead end* and workshops. At number 101 , *Villa Seurat* (Old houses of artists build in 1925). Turn left in the Rue Beaunier and walk along the *Réservoirs de Montsouris* (Aqueduct of the Loing river , names of rivers engraved).

Cross the Avenue Reille and enter in the *Square Montsouris* (paved street with a lot of beautiful houses). Turn right in the Rue Nansouty. On right , Rue Braque. Turn right in the *Rue du Parc Montsouris* (U shade). On right , *Villa du Parc Montsouris* (Private street) then the *Impasse Nansouty*. Enter on left in the Parc Montsouris. Take the *Allée Montsouris* then on right the *Allée du Puits* which is next to the *meteorologic station*.

On right , ***Mire du sud*** (Engraved words dating of Napoléon 1st , Mire du nord at the Butte Montmartre). Turn around the lake. Turn right in the ***Allée du Lac. Petite ceinture*** on right. Go downstairs and continue in the ***Rue Liard (Petite Ceinture*** railroads). Turn left in the Rue Auguste Lancon and enter on right in the ***Cité Florale***.

Turn right in the ***Rue des Glycines*** then on right in the ***Rue des Volubilis*** , then on left in the ***Rue des Iris*** then on right in the ***Rue des Glycines***. Turn right in the ***Rue des Liserons*** and get out of the ***Cité Florale***. Arrive on left in the Place de Rungis. Walk in the Rue de la Fontaine à Mulard along the ***Square de la Fontaine à Mulard*** on right.

Turn left in the Rue de la Colonie. On the ***Place de l'Abbé Hénocque*** , sightseeing on left in the Rue Ch. Fourier of the ***Eglise Ste Anne de la Maison Blanche***. Turn left in the Rue des Peupliers. Turn left in the Passage Foubert. Turn right in the Rue de Tolbiac then on right in the Rue du Moulin des Près. On left , ***Square des Peupliers***.

Turn right in the Rue Henri Pape then on left in the ***Rue Dieulafoy*** (Houses with Pignons). Turn right in the Rue du Dr Leray then on left in the ***Rue du Dr L. Championnière***. Turn right in the Rue Damesme , impasse damesme on left. Walk above the ***Petite Ceinture*** railroads (Old testing station for Météor trains). Enter on right in the ***Square de la Poterne des peupliers***.

Cross the Bd Kellermann and take the Rue du Prof. L. Renault. Enter in the ***Park Kellermann*** (Dating of 1937 , 5.6 Ha , above the Bièvre river bed. Get out of the park on the left side. Go upstairs and turn left in the Rue Paul Bourget. Enter in the ***Square Robert Barjac*** and cross the Avenue de la Porte d'Italie. Enter in the ***Square H. Boucher*** until the Porte d'Italie station.
