

ROUTE 6

Departure : Pte Maillot

Take the way under the road and enter in the *Bois de Boulogne*. On right , *Pavillon de l'Orée du Bois*. Walk along the Ruisseau d'Armenonville. On the other side of the avenue , Pavillon d'Armenonville. Turn left in the Rue des Sablons à la Porte Dauphine. Cross the Place du Maréchal de Lattre de Tassigny and turn left in the *Avenue Foch* (Dating of 1854 , Gardens along the Avenue). On left , *Villa Said*.

Pass in front of the *Station Porte Dauphine* (Style Guimard). On right , at number 16 of the Rue de la Faisanderie , *Musée de la Contrefaçon*. At 59 Avenue Foch , *Hôtel d'Ennery* (Musée d'Ennery). Turn right in the Rue de Presbourg. Cross the Avenue des Champs Elysées and take the Rue Arsène Houssaye , then on right the Rue Lord Byron.

Continue in the Rue Chateaubriand. Turn left in the Rue Washington. On right , *Cité Odiot* (Construite en 1847). Turn left in the Rue Lamennais. Continue in the Rue de Balzac (*Display* for Balzac) which is along a *square*. At the end of the street , *Eglise N. D. de l'Annonciation*. Turn right in the Rue Berryer (*Hôtel Salomon de Rothschild* with a garden) then on left in the Rue de Monceau. Arrive *Place du Pérou* (Pagode dating of 1928 , Built for Loo).

Turn left in the Rue Rembrandt. On right , at 9 Rue Murillo , *Remains of the Tuileries*. Continue in the Rue Rembrandt which goes to the *Parc Monceau* (Built in 1769 at the time of the Duc de Chartres, english style). Take the *Allée Comtesse de Ségur*. Get out of the Park by the *Avenue Velázquez*. See on right the *Musée Cernuschi* (Museum about the old china). Turn right in the Bd Malesherbes then on right in the Rue Monceau. At number 63 , *Musée Nissim de Camondo* (Arts décoratifs).

Turn left in the Rue de Téhéran. Display in the Avenue de Messine. At place Narvik , *Statue* and *Beautiful bookshop* Shakespeare. Turn left in the Rue Treilhard. Continue in the Rue de la Bienfaisance. Walk along the *Eglise St Augustin* (Built in 1861 by Baltard).

On left , *Square Marcel Pagnol* (dating of the 2nd Empire) then walk along the Bd Malesherbes on left. On left side of the place , *Centre de l'armée de terre de mer et d'air*. Turn left in the Rue de la Pépinière then on right in the Rue Pasquier. *Beautiful shop* and *animals* on a wall. Walk along the *square Louis XVI* (Vault Expiatoire, Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette were buried here in the old cemetery before their transfers to St Denis).

Take the *Passage Puteaux* on left. Turn right in the Rue Castellane then on right in the Rue Tronchet. Take the *passage de la Madeleine* on right. Turn left in the Rue de l'Arcade. Walk along the Bd Malesherbes. *Eglise de la Madeleine* (built in 1764) on left.

Enter on right in the *Galerie de la Madeleine* (Built in 1845) . See on right , the *Maille* shop. Turn left in the Rue de Boissy d'Anglas. on right , in the Rue du Faubourg St Honoré , the number 13 has been deleted by superstition by the Impératrice Eugénie. Enter in the *Village Royal* on left. Turn right in the Rue Royale then on left in the Rue St Honoré.

At number 398, *House* where lived Robespierre. At the corner of the Rue Duphot , *Barometer* above a shop. On right , *Notre Dame de l'Assomption*. Pass in front of the *Cour des Comptes* and the *Musée des lunettes et des lorgnettes*. Turn left and enter in the *Cour Vendôme* which arrives at the *Place Vendôme* (Luxury shops).

At number 9 , *old Hôtel d'Evreux*. At number 15 , *Hôtel Ritz*. At number 9, *Hôtel du Gouverneur militaire* (Ministère de la Justice inside it). *Mètre Etalon* dating of 1848. Turn left in the Rue de la Paix (*Display for Chopin*) then on right in the Rue Danielle Casanova then Rue Louis le Grand on left. Pass in front of the *Théâtre de la Potinière*.

Cross the Avenue de l'Opéra and continue in the Rue St Augustin. At the Place Gaillon , *Fontaine Gaillon* (1707) with dolphins and starfish and Restaurant Drouant (Prix Goncourt). On right in the Rue Monsigny , *Théâtre des Bouffes Parisiens*. Enter on right in the *Passage Choiseul* (built in 1827 at the place of an hotel dating of 1655). Exit of the passage on left by the *Passage Ste Anne*. On left , *Beautiful shop* and *pharmacy*. *Beautiful display* at the corner of the Rue Chérubini.

Continue in the Rue Chérubini then walk along the *Square Louvois* (1859 , fountain with names of rivers engraved). Take slightly on left the Rue Colbert which is along the *Bibliothèque Nationale*. Turn right in the Rue Vivienne. Enter on left in the *Galerie Vivienne* (Built in 1823 by Vivienne on the site of 3 hotels, Competed with *Galerie Colbert* next to it).

Turn left in the *Passage des Petits pères*. *Maison Bleue* on the Small place. Walk along the *basilique de N. D. des Victoires* (Built into 1629 for the victory of Richelieu over the Protestant). Turn right in the *Rue Vide Gousset* (Name engraved in 1729). It arrives *Place des Victoires* (Statue dating of 1686 for the victory of Louis 14th).

Turn right in the Rue Feuillade then on left in the Rue Vivienne which arrives at the Jardins du Palais Royal (Built between 1624 and 1639). On right , see *Restaurant Vefour* and Passage du Louvre and Display for Colette. Get out of the park by the left side of the park. Turn right in the Rue Valois (at number 8 , display "*Le Bœuf à la Mode*"). Turn left an pass the Place de Valois then the Passage Vérité. Continue in the Rue Montesquieu.

Enter on right in the *Galerie Véro Dodat* (Built in 1826 by 2 porkbutchers for speculations real). Turn left in the Rue Jean Jacques Rousseau and cross the Rue du Louvre. Turn left in the Rue de Viarmes on the right side of the *Bourse du Commerce* (Old place of the Hôtel de Nesles where died Blanche de Castille) , on right *Colonne Médicis* (Astrologic column , old place of an hotel build for Catherine de Médicis).

Turn right in the Rue Sauval (small house). Turn left in the Rue St Honoré. *Village St Honoré* on right , then "*Renommée des Herbes Cuites*". Turn left in the Rue des Prouvaires. In front of the street , *Eglise Ste Eustache* (Gothic church dating of 1532) (*Sundial*). Turn right along the *Jardin des Halles*. In the Rue du Pont Neuf , *Statue of Molière*.

Turn right in the Passage des Lingères. Turn left in the Rue des Halles. Beautiful *Edicule Guimard*. Turn left in the Rue St Opportune then on right in the Rue de la Ferronnerie. At number 11 , *Lys flower* at the place where was killed Henri the 4th (1610 by Ravailiac). Turn right in the Rue St Denis then on left in the Rue des Lombards. then on left in the Rue Quincampoix (*Beautiful houses*) , then on right in the *Rue de Venise* (Thinest street of Paris).

Walk on the left side of the Centre Georges Pompidou and come back on right on the Rue Rambuteau. Cross the Rue Beaubourg. On left , **Musée de la Poupée**. Turn right in the Rue Geoffroy Langevin. Turn right in the Rue du Temple. Then, on right Rue Simon le Franc (**engraved name**). At number 41 , dead end , **Café de la Gare** (Hôtel de Berlize , beams dating of Louis XIII).

Turn left in the Rue Ste Croix de la Bretonnerie (Oldest street of Paris , 1270). Enter on right , in the **Square Ste Croix de la Bretonnerie**. at number 24 , Rue des Archives , **Cloître des Billettes** (medieval cloister dating of 1427 with large vaults). Turn left then right to come back on the Rue Ste Croix de la Bretonnerie. At the angle of the Rue Aubriot , **Statue**. On right , in the Rue du Bourg Tibourg , **Musée du Thé** ("Mariage Frères").

Turn left in the Rue Vieille du Temple. On left , **Hôtel Amelot de Bisseul** (Old place in 1655 of the house of Du Guesclin's comrades-in-arms). Far away on left , **Hotel de Rohan** (Build in 1705 , "Chevaux du soleil" above the door). Turn right in the Rue des Rosiers then on left in the Rue des Hospitalières St Gervais (at number 8 , Big bulls at the place of an old market).

At the corner of the street , **J. Hérouet house** (Turrets dating of Louis 12th). Turn right in the Rue des Francs Bourgeois. On left , at number 38, **Impasse des Arbalétriers** (1607 , for Henri 4th, House of Isabeau de Bavière at the beginning of the 14th century). At number 36 , **Pharmacy** in the place of a house of alms of the 16th century.

At number 39 , "**Traitement des cendres Essais et Analyses**". At number 30 , **Hôtel d'Almeyras** , at number 41 , **Musée Kwok on** (Theatrical traditions of Asia) , at number 35 , **Hôtel de Sandreville** , at number 33 , **Hôtel de Coulanges** , then **Hôtel d'Albret** (Built by the Constable of Montmorency at the 16th century) , at 29 , Shop with the frontage of an **old bakery**. Walk along the **Musée Carnavalet** (History of Paris, built by Mansart into 1568).

On right , **Hôtel Lamoignon** (Built by Diane de France in 1585 , bibliothèque historique de Paris). Turn right in the Rue Sévigné (**Old bakery display**). at number 10, **beautiful display**. Turn left in the Rue de Jarente. On right , **Placette du Marché Ste Catherine**. Turn left in the Rue de Turenne then on right in the Rue des Francs Bourgeois.

Arrive in the **Place des Vosges** (Built in 1607 for Henri 4th). **Musée Victor Hugo** on right (at number 6) in the **Hotel de Sully**. Display for **Mme de Sévigné** on right. **Sundial** on the hotel. Turn right in the Rue du pas de la mule. Cross the Bd Beaumarchais and continue in the Rue du Pasteur Wagner (**Beautiful bakery display**) then the Rue Amelot on right.

Walk along the Bd Richard Lenoir (**Canal St Martin** under it) until the **Place de la Bastille** (Old prison and revolution place in 1789). Turn left in the Rue du Faubourg St Antoine. On left , **Passage du Cheval Blanc** (below a building of the 17th century). On left , **Cité Marchappe** , **Cour St Louis** , **Cour du Nom de Jésus**.

On right , **Cour du Bel Air** (Old hotel , Grapes on frontage). At numbers 16 and 18 , **sculptures** at the top of the high windows. at number 25, **posts out of cast iron**. at number 30, **decoration of ceramics**. at number 38, **frontage out of plated wooden**. **Beautiful display** on right. On left **Cour de l'Etoile d'Or** (**Sundial** of the 18th century) , **Cour des 3 frères** , **Cour de la Maison Brûlée** , **Cour de l'Ours** (Bear on the door).

Turn left in the Rue de Charonne. On left, *display* about the Seine flood in 1910. On left , *cour Delépine*. Turn right in the *Passage Lhomme* (Workshops on the Work of Wood since 1886). Turn left in the Rue de Charonne. At the corner of the street, *Café style 1900* . Turn right in the Avenue Ledru Rollin (*Beautiful Bakery* on right) then on left in the *Passage de la Bonne Graine*.

Turn left in the Rue du Faubourg St Antoine then on right in the Rue Cotte which is along the *Square Trousseau*. At number 3 , "*Ancien Lavoir du Marché Lenoir*" (Dating of 1830) , then walk along the *Marché Beauveau St Antoine* (Aligre,dating of 1777). Turn left in the Rue de Charenton then on right in the Rue Hector Malet.

Go upstairs on the *Promenade Plantée* (Old railroad between the Bastille and the Petite Ceinture). Arrive at the Jardin de Reuilly (*Large Sundial*). Continue in the *Allée Vivaldi* (Old Station of Reuilly on right). Continue in the *Promenade Plantée*. On left , *Villa du Sahel*. Pass under the *Petite Ceinture*.

Turn left in the Bd Soult then on left in the *Sentier de la Lieutenance*. Enter in the *Villa du Bel-Air* (Tied with Paris in 1860). Walk along the *Petite Ceinture* (Old station on left). Continue in the Rue du Gabon. Turn left in the Rue de la Voute then the *passage de la Voûte* on right. On left , *Impasse Vassou* and *Impasse Canart* until the Station Porte de Vincennes.
